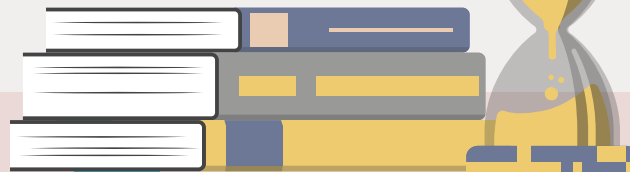


What are the subjects of administrative law?

- **Public Administration** – الإدارة العامة
- **Administrative Authority** – السلطة الإدارية
- **Administrative Decision** – القرار الإداري
- **Administrative Act** – التصرف الإداري

PRONOUNS

PERSONAL PRONOUNS

a substitute for a person's name

I, you, he, she, it, we, they, me, you, her, him, it, us, them

POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS

show ownership or possession of a noun

mine, yours, hers, his, its, ours, theirs

REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

refer back to the subject of the clause or sentence

myself, yourself, herself, himself, itself, ourselves, yourselves, themselves

RECIPROCAL PRONOUNS

used to express a mutual action or relationship

Each other, one another

DEMONSTRATIVE PRONOUNS

point to and identify a noun or a pronoun

these, those, this, that, such

INDEFINITE PRONOUNS

refer to a person or a thing without being specific

all, another, any, anybody, anyone, anything, each, everybody, everyone, everything, few, many, nobody, none, one, several, some, somebody, someone

RELATIVE PRONOUNS

link one phrase or clause to another phrase or clause

who, whom, which, whoever, whomever, whichever, that

INTERROGATIVE PRONOUNS

used to ask questions

who, whom, which, what, whoever, whomever, whichever, whatever
